The Company also has undertaken a leadership role in developing safety programs for its employees and seeking environmental solutions for its clients.

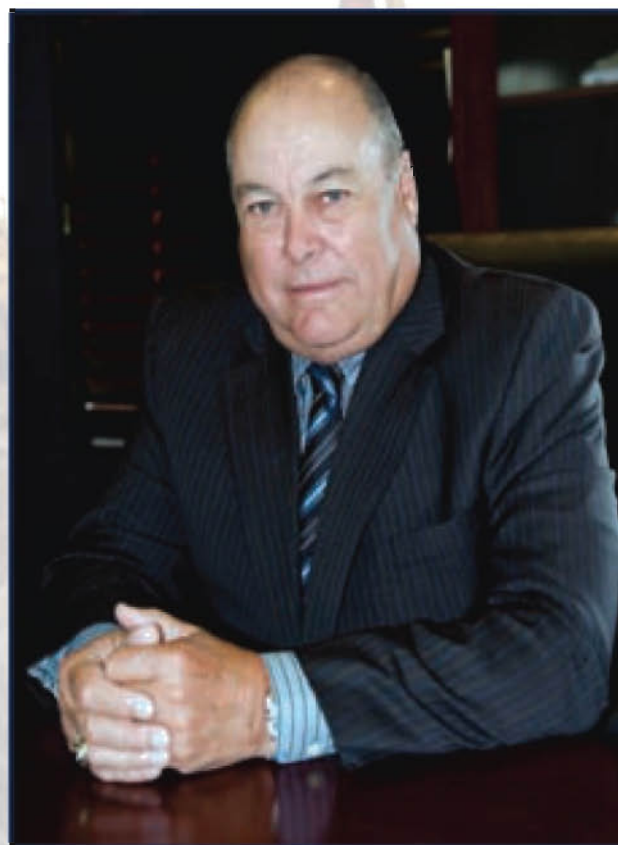
AN OUTSTANDING FUTURE
