The number of employees working within the division ranges between 75 and 250 individuals, depending on the number and scope of jobs in which the division is currently engaged.

On average, this division lays some 300 kilometres of pipe per year.

- 55,000m 8" poly for Taqa North near Carstairs
- 43,000m 16", 12" and 10" for InterPipeline

### SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT

Mainline pipeline requires an assortment of specialized equipment. The division has the following units within its inventory, and available to any project:

- CRC 6"-20" Hydraulic Bending Machine
- ThreeWolfe Plows capable of ploughing 2"-8" polyethylene pipe, 2"-6" composite pipe and 2"-4" steel pipe to a depth of 1.8m
- Tandem axle water trucks equipped with high pressure tri-plex pumps for hydro testing pipelines
- Sullair 900 CFM 300 PSI Compressor complete with Dessicant Air Dryers good to -50C Dewpoint

- 14H Graders
- FastFusion Mobile Trac Machine capable of fusing poly pipe from 3"-12"
- Six HydroVac Trucks, equipped for winter work
- Pipeline crews are equipped with job vans fully supplied with R.O.W. signage, batter boards, small tools and consumables to complete all types of pipeline installations.
- Cats from D6 to D9 equipped with single and multi shank rippers and topsoil cutters.
- Sidebooms from 583s to D3s and rubber tire 580s
- Iron Wolf (mulching frozen topsoil and mulching bush)
- Tractor Units, Picker Trucks, Highboys and Lowbeds, 15 track hoes, 50 trucks, vans, and one-tons.

With this collection of equip-

ment and trained employees, the division can easily handle five spreads at a time, each utilizing 75 men.

The division is capable of handling any size of project, from 2" to 48" involving steel, poly, Flexsteel, Flexpipe and Fiberspar, and it has access to an unlimited amount of equipment available from other divisions within the Company.
