MAJOR FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION

The Major Facilities Construction Group is headquartered at the White City location.

This division specializes in construction and plant upgrades, demolition and plant maintenance. All phases and all sizes of civil, structural and mechanical work are done by this division. Our services also include supply and installation of scaffolding, as well as a large variety of safety training and safety services.

Currently, construction is in process for a main office and specialized facilities including a fabrication shop equipped with overhead crane equipment, quality control, x-ray, hydrotesting, blasting and painting areas, and safety services areas.



MAINLINE PIPELINE

The Mainline Pipeline Division, centered at the new White City location, is capable of handling any size of mainline pipeline project, from 2" to 48" in diameter; located anywhere within Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Alberta, involving steel, poly, Flexsteel, Flexpipe and Fiberspar.
